

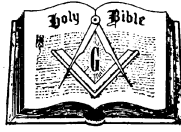

This communication will be at the Peekskill Elks Hall, 1038 Brown Street, Peekskill, N.Y.

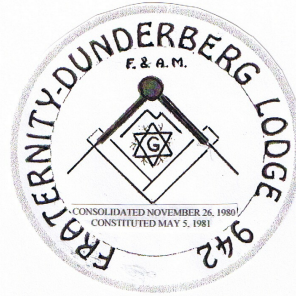
